Apply for training through the Highway Construction Careers Training Program (HCCTP)

at Dawson Technical Institute of Kennedy-King College.

- **Must be 18+, have a high school diploma or GED, a valid driver's license and successfully complete drug screenings**
- Training sessions available in the fall and spring
- Free for qualified individuals
- Qualified students will also enjoy program benefits, including boots, tools, and supportive services

Get trained in highway construction-related skills

- 16-week intensive training, eight hours a day, five days a week
- Learn skills, such as:
 - Mathematics for the trades
 - Job site readiness
 - Carpentry
 - Concrete flatwork
 - Blueprint reading
 - Introduction to tools
 - Forklift operation
 - Flagger
 - Scaffolding
 - OSHA 10 certification
